Harald Johansson's violin is hereby announced available for loan to V-Dalings

The First curator must receive the application no later than August 31st 2021 at 18:00

The violin, which the state geologist file. Dr. Harald Elias Johansson (b. 1880, registered at Stockholm University the spring semester of 1895 and at the nation 1897, died 1931) received as a friendly gift on his 50th birthday, was gifted to the nation in the spring semester of 1968 by its' then inspector, the nephew of Harald Johansson.

Västmanlands-Dala nation hereby announces the violin of Harald Johansson available for loan by a musically interested and somewhat experienced violin-playing V-Daling. The violin of Harald Johansson is a violin in good condition, which is lent to a V-Daling after applying to the First curator. The violin has been lent out since 1968 and spread joy in both corridors and apartments. Assignment of the violin is made two semesters at a time, with the possibility of applying for an extension. The holder is responsible for ensuring that the instrument is well cared for and returned in undamaged condition. Though it is not required, it would be greatly appreciated if the lender of the violin would perform something at the nation at a time of their choosing.
